Glen Careedy, Chief Executive Officer of Bendigo Primary Care Centre Limited, illustrates the numerous advantages Convene has which ultimately led them to choose the solution.

Before using Convene, Bendigo did their meetings with printed board packs, digitally distributed to each participant beforehand. However, it proved to be too time consuming to arrange packets with more than a hundred and fifty pages for each of their eight board members attending their monthly meeting; plus, the fifty-page meeting packs for the committee meetings.

Better Opportunity Costs

Preparing the necessary files alone exhausted too many resources and proved to be unfeasible. For instance, Glen's assistant used to take about two hours to consolidate all the documents for the board meetings; all the while, she was paid around \$50 an hour, amounting to \$100 per month just to put together a meeting pack. Additionally, the preparation time for the committee meeting's pack is another \$100, amounting to \$200 for building the board packs per month. That's approximately \$2,400 on pre-meeting preparation alone, excluding printing costs. With Convene, the time spent preparing the meeting packs has been drastically cut down; thus, allowing Bendigo to focus their time and resources towards more important matters.

One Centralised Tool

Last minute revisions were also an issue as members would show up with the previous versions of meeting packs, causing confusion.

"We would compile the first digital version and let's say, we wait a week, and then we would find out that there was an error or there is new information. So, we would make this modification to the pack—a new version of the pack, and sometimes it would happen 2 to 3 times. Then the directors are never sure which version of the pack they were actually reading," Glen recalls.

Bendigo needed one central tool that would help them avoid any confusion. Convene answered that need as it allows users to easily update the agenda, as well as uploaded documents, while automatically synchronising all the amendments across all devices in real time. Convene also notifies participants of any changes, and alerts them if new meeting pack versions have to be downloaded.

Effortless Remote Meetings

Another factor that prompted Bendigo to go digital was not just the printing and last minute revisions—one director had moved into another state. They still needed to run meetings and have an updated board pack for the out-of-state director.
